As part of our Animation theme, Plus and Advance are working on their own 'stop motion animation' short film.

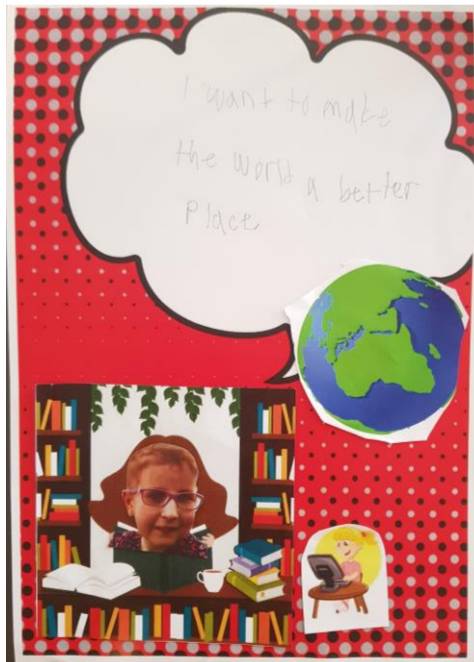
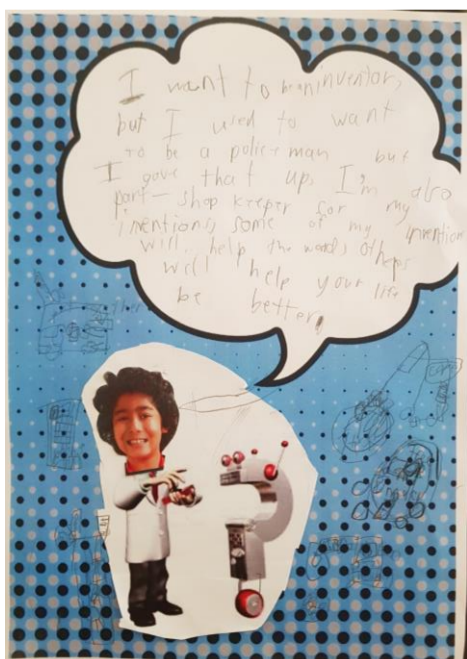
They have taken the role of story board writer, editor, animator, special effect creator, producer and editor.

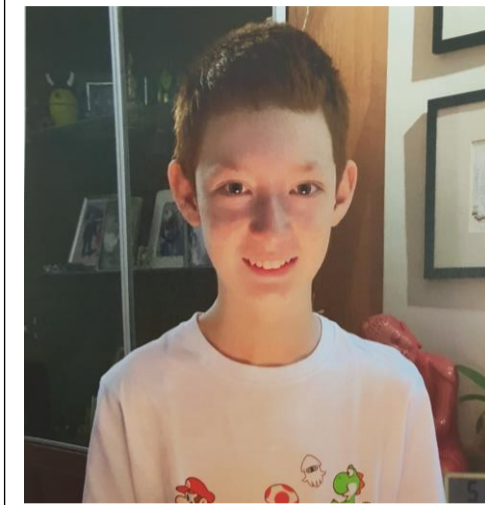
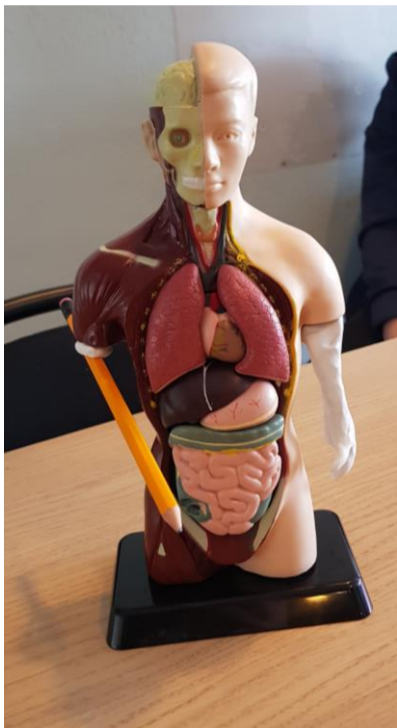

## Food Testing

In Science we did two experiments to demonstrate chemical reactions when testing foods. We used iodine and corn starch to check for different chemicals and enzymes present in food.



One of the properties of iodine is that it turns dark purple in the presence of starch.



Vitamin C buffers the reaction between the iodine and starch and makes the purple colour disappear.
