They have explored plant cells, dissected flowers, investigated how flowers drink and plant pollination.

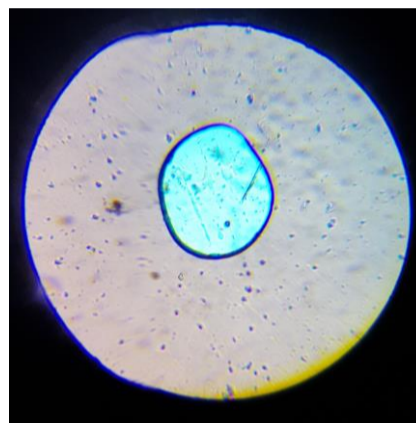


Michelle and Daniel dissected flowers into their structural parts: sepals, petals, stamens, pollen and pistils.

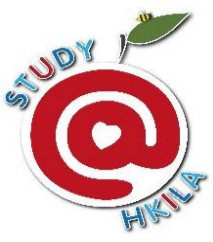

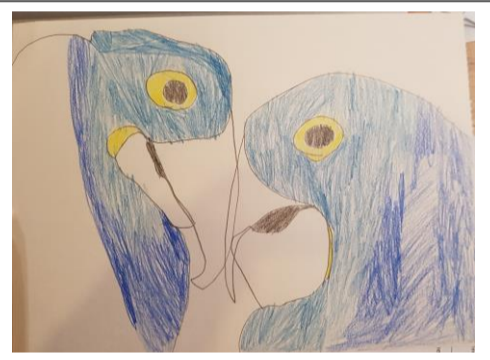
